

## The Armor of God (cont.)

### Power of Prayer

With all of the “armor” afforded us, none is perhaps more important than that of prayer. It might be a cliché, but – prayer definitely changes things. Paul tells us in Ephesians 6:18 to “pray always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit.” Praying in the Holy Ghost must have immense benefits if Paul said to do it ALWAYS. No matter how skilled we might be with the rest of our armor, without prayer we will suffer defeat. Like Gideon, we need to keep our communication lines always open with our commander, Yeshua in case He changes our attack plan. He is the One who assures us of victory. Occasionally soldiers get weary of fighting; but, praise God, He has not left us empty handed. Yeshua gave us a model for praying in Matthew 6 and when we’ve worn that out Romans 8:26 says, “Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit [itself] makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.” In Matthew 7:7-8 Yeshua assured us of answered prayer: “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.”


